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Personal Care Aide (PCA) Blended Training

Personal Care Aide Training is an excellent opportunity for individuals interested in pursuing a career in the rewarding healthcare field. Students who complete the training will receive a Silver Care, LLC Personal Care Aide Certificate.

PCAs will likely work in clients' homes, assisted living facilities, or other facilities. They will help clients complete daily living activities such as exercise, walking, bathing, and grooming. In addition, they may also be expected to do some light housekeeping, run errands, and participate in meal preparation. The course consists of an intensive 40 hours of training over a 2-week training period.

Cost and Registration Requirements

- Training Cost \$300. A non-refundable fee that covers all expenses for blended home care training and testing.
- You must be at least 18 years of age.
- You must provide your own equipment/internet access for the online portion
- You must provide transportation to the training location's hands-on portion. (Present Government Issued ID)
- You must attest to having a clear criminal record (no barrier crimes listed in § 32.1-162.9:1 of the Code of Virginia.)

What is expected of participants to become certified as a PCA during the training?

The program consists of 40 hours of training online and blended over a 2-week training period and will be a combination of online training, hands-on, and testing. Attendance is **mandatory** to complete the training and receive a PCA Certificate from Silver Care, LLC.

- Students must log in on the first day of an online class to start the training.
- It will be necessary for students to ask questions and to ask for help in understanding PCA roles, responsibilities, and review during the hands-on training.
- Throughout the training program, students will be selected for completion based on the following criteria:
 - 1. Completing the online portion of the training
 - 2. Passing the PCA Certification testing/hands-on portion
 - 3. Maturity and ability to deal effectively with the demands of the work
 - 4. Satisfactory completion of all the required home care online training, review, and testing in accordance with the program curriculum.
